Announcement of Visa Exemption to enter Myanmar for ordinary passport holders of Japan, South Korea, Hong Kong and Macao Administrative Region of China

The tourists from Japan and South Korea who hold the ordinary passports, were granted visa–free entry to Republic of the Union of Myanmar with effect from $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ October 2018 to 30^{th} September 2019 as a trial (1) year period.

The Ministry of Labour, Immigration and Population will now extended the scheme of visa exemption for another one year for the visitors from Japan, South Korea, Hong Kong and Macao Special Administrative Region of China starting from $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ October 2019 to $\mathbf{30}^{\text{th}}$ September 2020 as a trial.

Announcement of Visa on Arrival (Tourists)

The Ministry of Labour, Immigration and Population allowed the ordinary passport holders from China to apply the visa on arrival (Tourist) in Myanmar for one year trial period with affect from $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ October 2018.

The Ministry of Labour, Immigration and Population will now extended the scheme of visa on arrival for another one year for Chinese Citizens starting from 1st October 2019 to 30th September 2020. Likewise, the holders of Indian ordinary passports will also be permitted for visa on arrival (Tourists) for one year starting from 1st December 2019 to 30thNovember 2020.
